- WHEREAS,** the Community Assistance Center is vital to the health and safety of many of our community's residents who are homeless or at-risk of homelessness; and
- WHEREAS,** our community has experienced an upsurge of need during the past year; and
- WHEREAS,** individuals experiencing homelessness are in need of a balanced diet and often are unable to obtain healthy food; and
- WHEREAS,** Matthew Polasko took the initiative to design and implement an innovative program through the University of Nevada, Reno's student cafeteria to provide assistance in meeting the nutritional needs of families with children at the Community Assistance Center; and
- WHEREAS,** by allowing University students to donate their unused "swipes," the program provided \$7,352.42 in the 2009-2010 school year to supply healthy food options for the Family Shelter clients; and
- WHEREAS,** the Reno City Council recognizes Matthew Polasko for his efforts in support of the shelter services and providing valuable resources to improve the quality of life for community residents most in need.
