Team Registration is a new part of the Reno/Tahoe Senior Games for 2014. Your group or organization can compete in the games this year-- much like a country in the Olympic Games. The purpose is to generate excitement, have fun and earn some bragging rights when your team members win medals!

To participate, just register your team name, for example: "Love 2 Hike Club", then get up to (10) people age 50 or older to join by registering for at least one sport in the Senior Games. *Each participant must complete an individual registration form and list team name.* Once a team reaches (10) members, an additional leg of up to (10) members may be added with no additional team fees. Points are awarded for the combined medals your team members have won. Example: Love 2 Hike Club– Leg blue has ten who win 3 gold medals x 3 points = 9 points, 10 silver medals x 2 points = 20 points and 1 bronze medal x 1 point = 1 point with a total combined score of 30 points toward your team total medals won.

Note: Teams must be limited to (10) people per leg. A team can have as many legs as they want at no additional fee. The purpose is to give all teams, regardless of size, an equal chance to win trophies. The team's leg with the most points will be entered into the trophy competition. Team registration and rosters are due no later than closing of business day February 3, 2014.

Fee(s): \$100 (for-profit business) and \$25 (non-profit/social clubs)

What you get for your Team registration:

1. Winner's Trophy (First, Second and Third place for most overall team points)
2. Teams and Winners listed in the Reno monthly publication, Senior Connect, and Reno.gov/seniorgames
3. Teams and winners listed in a City of Reno News Release
4. Exhibit space for your business /organization during registration at Harrah's
