SUBJECT: Fall 2024 Community Cleanup Data

Housing and Neighborhood Development (HAND) successfully completed six Fall city-wide community cleanups. The locations throughout the City of Reno were provided to residents through a variety of sources. The collective data for fall is listed below.

- 1,059 residents assisted
- 1,260 yards of unwanted household items collected
- 69,645 lbs. of electronic waste collected
- 10,692 lbs. of hazardous waste collected
- 7,150 gal. of paint collected
- 866 appliances collected
- 57 bikes collected and donated to local organizations
- 300 lbs. of lithium batteries diverted from the landfill.

Each Community Cleanup costs \$7,500 for hazardous and electronic waste disposal through a third-party vendor. At this time, waste management disposal, including green waste, does not have an associated cost.

On June 12, 2024, Council allocated \$50,000 in FY23/24 funds to the Community Cleanup Program, which was utilized for Fall 2024 cleanups. HAND currently has no funding for 2025 cleanups, but staff is exploring grant opportunities. As of now, 2025 cleanups will be limited to waste management disposal only.
