SUBJECT: Fall 2025 Community Cleanups – Hazardous Waste and E-Waste Disposal

Housing and Neighborhood Development (HAND) is pleased to announce that Waste Management will sponsor household hazardous waste (HHW) and electronic waste (e-waste) disposal during the City of Reno's Fall 2025 *Biggest Little Fall Refresh* Community Clean-Up events. This sponsorship allows residents to safely and responsibly dispose of unwanted hazardous and electronic items at no cost to the City.

Due to the timing of the funding commitment, the first Fall Community Clean-Up event held on September 20, 2025, did not include HHW and e-waste collection. However, all remaining clean-up events this fall will offer HHW and e-waste disposal services. To ensure fairness and equitable access for all residents, staff has scheduled an additional event on November 8, 2025 specifically for Ward 4 residents to dispose of HHW and e-waste.

Waste Management's support expands access to safe disposal options and helps reduce the environmental and public health risks associated with improper waste handling.

The City sincerely appreciates Waste Management's continued partnership and dedication to environmental stewardship and enhancing the quality of life for Reno residents.
