SUBJECT: January 2025 City Walk Outcomes

City Walks proactively assess concerns in real-time, identify solutions, improve the quality of life for residents, and expediate services to vulnerable populations. City Walks occur weekly, Monday through Thursday.

- Monday and Wednesday walks are coordinated based on service requests. These walks may occur anywhere within the City of Reno, including DEEDS coordinated areas.
- Tuesday and Thursday walks are dedicated to areas within the Business Improvement District (BID). Locations are coordinated by the Downtown Reno Partnership.

The following is an overview of City Walk outcomes for January 2025.
