SUBJECT: June 2025 City Walk Outcomes

City Walks proactively assess concerns in real-time, identify solutions, improve the quality of life for residents, and expedite services to vulnerable populations. City Walks occur weekly, Monday through Thursday.

- Monday and Wednesday walks are coordinated based on service requests. These walks may occur anywhere within the City of Reno, including DEEDS coordinated areas.
- Tuesdays and Thursday walks are dedicated to areas within the Business Improvement District (BID). Locations are coordinated by the Downtown Reno Partnership.
