SUBJECT: Spring 2025 Community Cleanup Data

Housing and Neighborhood Development (HAND) successfully completed six city-wide community cleanups during Spring 2025. The locations throughout the City of Reno were provided to residents through a variety of sources. Five of the six cleanups included hazardous and electronic waste disposal. A summary of the spring cleanup data is provided below.

- 1,416 households assisted
- 1,220 yards of unwanted household items collected
- 85,630 lbs. of electronic waste collected
- 11,071 lbs. of hazardous waste collected
- 8,520 gal. of paint collected
- 364 appliances collected
- 53 bikes collected and donated to local organizations
- 475 lbs. of lithium batteries diverted from the landfill

Due to budget constraints and shifting priorities, the City currently does not have funding for hazardous and electronic waste collection for the Fall 2025 community cleanups. At this time, Fall 2025 cleanups will be limited to waste management disposal services only. Staff are actively exploring grant and philanthropic support to help bridge this gap for future cleanups.
