---

Housing and Neighborhood Development (HAND) successfully completed six city-wide community cleanups during spring 2026, with one cleanup held in each of Reno's six wards. Cleanup locations were strategically selected throughout the city to maximize neighborhood impact and were communicated to residents through a variety of outreach methods, ensuring broad community awareness and participation. All six community cleanups included seven 30-yard Waste Management container bins. A summary of the spring cleanup data is provided below.

- 708 households assisted
- 1,260 yards of unwanted household items collected

As outlined in the memorandum provided to the City Council on December 18, 2025, staff previously advised that hazardous and electronic waste collection would be excluded from the Spring 2026 community cleanup events due to budgetary limitations. At this time, no additional funding has been identified to reinstate these services. Consequently, the Fall 2026 community cleanups will remain limited to Waste Management disposal services only.
