I am a fourth-generation Nevadan, mother, and prosecutor with nearly 20 years of courtroom experience handling thousands of cases ranging from complex felonies to misdemeanor offenses. For the past nine years, I have focused my experience on the core matters heard in municipal court—misdemeanors, traffic offenses and ordinance violations. I have also worked in specialty courts at the Reno Municipal Court, which play a vital role in addressing underlying issues, reducing repeat offenses, and enhancing public safety through accountability and structured support.

As a judge, I will uphold the rule of law while treating everyone with dignity, patience, and respect. I believe in accountability, equal justice, and making decisions based on facts and law, without favoritism or bias. I am dedicated to maintaining an efficient courtroom, issuing timely and fair rulings, and ensuring that all parties are heard.
