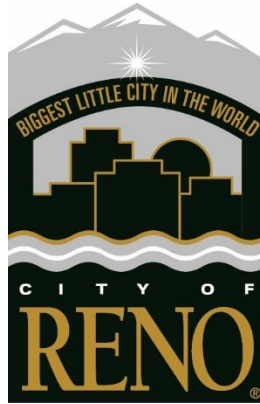

## **GEOTECHNICAL INVESTIGATION for WEST WASH DAM and EAST WASH DIVERSION DAM**

Dear Property Owner/Tenant:

The City of Reno and United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) is gathering data and information for the West Wash Dam Rehabilitation Project related to the Supplemental Watershed Plan and Environmental review. Geotechnical investigation work is scheduled for **Monday, March 24, 2025 through April 11, 2025**.

Starting Monday, March 24, 2025, field investigation work will occur to analyze the existing soil properties in approximately twelve locations within the West Wash Dam and the East Wash Diversion Dam. Two of the locations will consist of test pits with depths of 12 feet. The other ten locations will consist of soil borings with depths ranging from 20 feet to 150 feet. The work will be within the dam limits (see attached map on back of this page) and there will be minimal if any impact on the adjacent streets and sidewalks to the dams. We anticipate completion by Friday, April 11, 2025. Working hours may be from 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM (Monday through Saturday). The digging and borings will be using construction equipment that will be noisy at times.
