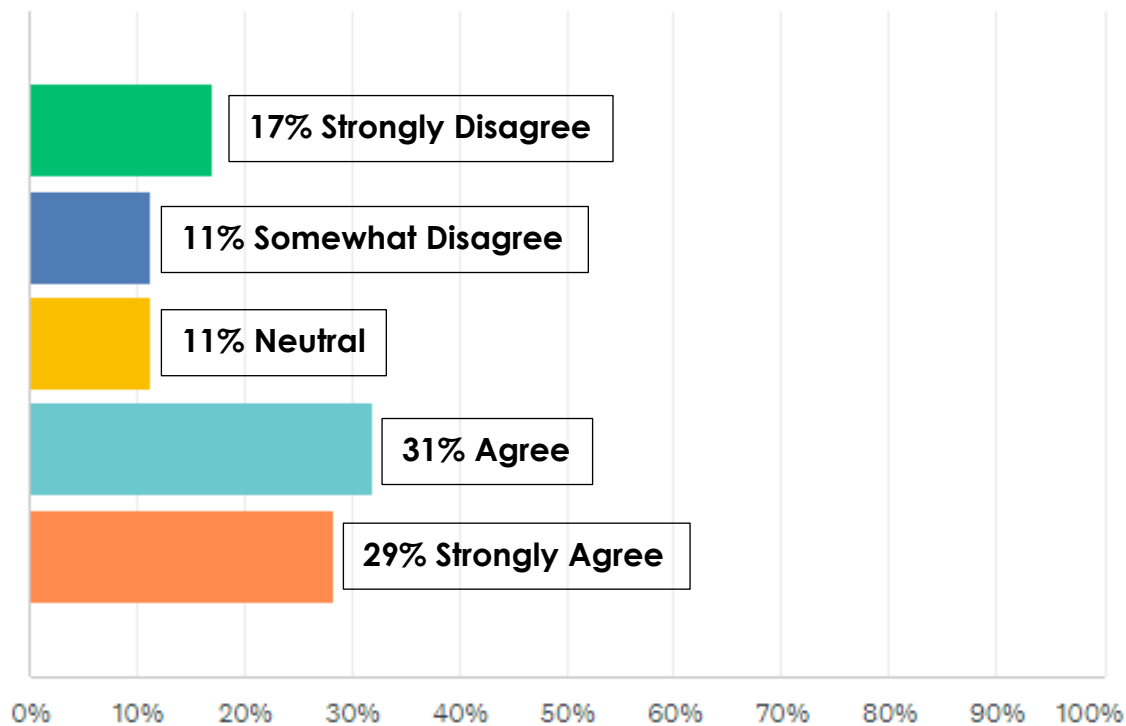


Paradise Park Master Plan Survey #2 Results

Total Respondents: 61 online

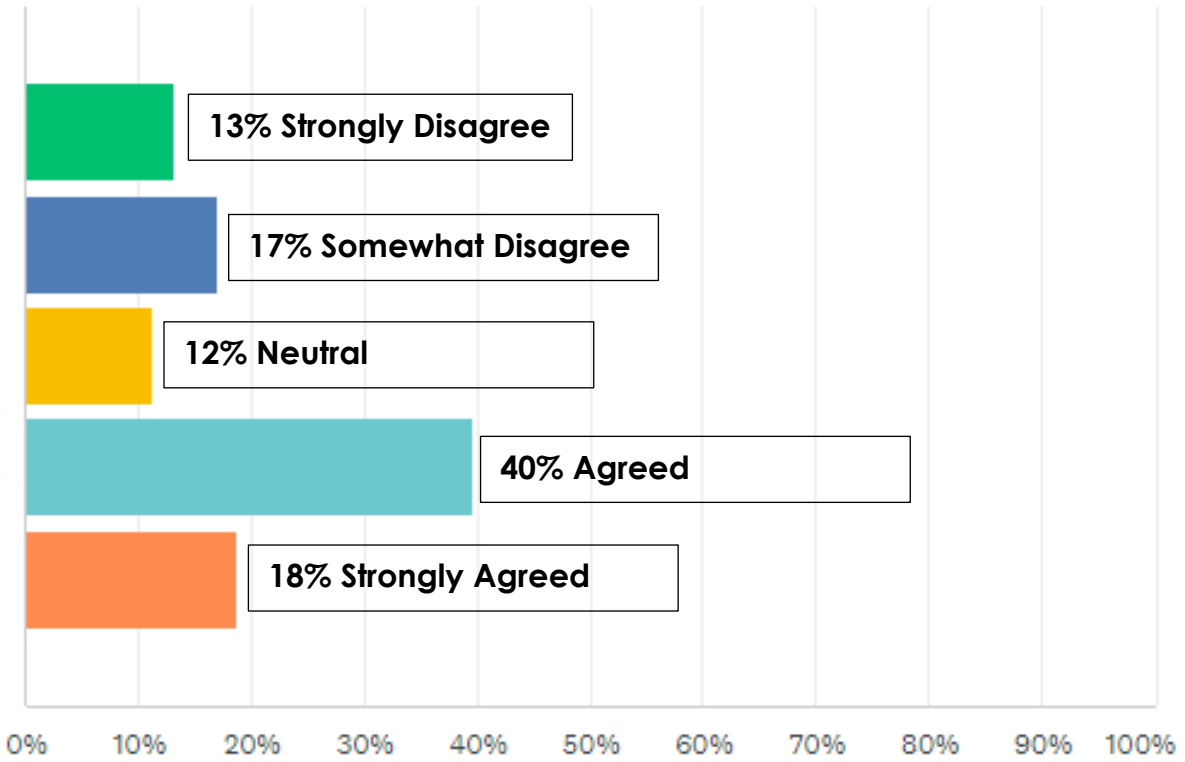
Q1 – Overall, do you agree with the location and size of park features shown in Concept A for Paradise Park?

Majority of people (60%) agreed with Concept A for Paradise Park



Q2 – Overall, do you agree with the location and size of park features shown in Concept B for Paradise Park?

Slightly fewer people (58%) preferred Concept B for Paradise Park



Q3 – Please select your preference for the following park features, size and location.

Soccer Field in Center (Concept A)

64% answered yes & **35%** answered no.

Open Turf in Center (Concept B)

49% answered yes & **50%** answered no.

Bocce Ball (Concept A)

46% answered yes & **54%** answered no.

Dog Park Large Size (Concept A)

61% answered yes & **42%** answered no.

Dog Park Medium Size (Concept B)

57% answered yes & **43%** answered no.

Skate Park Moveable Features on Paved Surface (Concept A)

47% answered yes & **53%** answered no.

Skate Park Permanent Features (Concept B)

48% answered yes & **52%** answered no.

Pump Track (Concept B)

59% answered yes & **41%** answered no.

Basketball – 2 Courts (Concept A)

52% answered yes & **48%** answered no.

Basketball – 1 Court (Concept B)

59% answered yes & **41%** answered no.

Volleyball Court (Concept B)

54% answered yes & **46%** answered no.

Sport Court (Concept A)

73% answered yes & **27%** answered no.

Community Garden (Concept B)

80% answered yes & **20%** answered no.

Pollinator Garden

85% answered yes & **15%** answered no.

Q4 – What additional Comments do you have about the concept Plans?

“...**interpretive signage** regarding all **flora and fauna** throughout the park, especially with regard to the animals (ducks, geese, swans, turtles, etc.) and explaining waterfowl migration patterns and the place Truckee Meadows/greater Nevada have in their lifecycle...”

“effective **litter** mitigation strategies”

“...no areas in the design have been left to **nature**... Please don't make a hostile environment for the turtles, frogs, many species of birds and other wildlife”

“needs good night time **lighting**”

“...this neighborhood and kids in it lack **green space** and **nature**. A lawn for playing all games is better than single sport courts. Keep our small urban natural spaces natural.”

“...provide **basketball** courts with lower hoops for **youth**...”

“...**soccer** field would thrive if included...”

“...need **natural**, open, green spaces for community/lounging/relaxing...”

“...many skate parks around the area... provide a covered, outdoor, regulation sized flat track **skating rink** instead”

“Improve the **shoreline** on the ponds. Give easy access to the water line as much as possible for fishing or model boats.”
