Please submit an initial privileged secondhand sales vendor list with application. A final list of privileged secondhand sales vendors is due at least <u>fifteen (15) days prior</u> to the activity.

The City of Reno is obligated to follow Nevada Revised Statutes as it pertains to "Secondhand Dealer" requirements (see definition below). If any of your vendors are engaging in the buying or selling of secondhand goods (except for the specific exclusions identified in NRS 647.018) it is a requirement that you as the event organizer and they as secondhand sales vendors at the event obtain the proper background check.

## NRS 647.018 "Secondhand dealer" defined.

- 1. "Secondhand dealer" means any person engaged in whole or in part in the business of buying and selling metal junk, melted metals or secondhand personal property, **other than antiques and used books, including, without limitation, coins and collectibles**.
- 2. The term does not include a person who engages in the business of buying or selling secondhand firearms or any antique parts, accessories or other equipment relating to those firearms if:
  - (a) The person engages in that business at a show that:
    - (1) Is held at:
      - (I) A convention facility which is owned or operated by and located on the premises of a resort hotel; or
      - (II) A recreational facility which is owned or operated by a county fair and recreation board; and
    - (2) Is conducted for not more than 7 days during any 6-month period; and
  - (b) The person has been issued a license as a manufacturer, importer, dealer or collector pursuant to the provisions of 18 U.S.C. § 923. (Added to NRS by 1997, 2547; A 1999, 2546; 2003, 653; 2009, 767)

As the Event/Activity Organizer, I understand it is my responsibility to:

- Collect and submit all State or other entity-required, taxes and fees.
- Ensure all vendors and exhibitors have a valid annual City of Reno business license, OR
- Pay for temporary licensing fees for unlicensed vendors and exhibitors.
- Obtain required work card for all privileged sales per vendor
