Project Description & Purpose

Slurry Seal is typically applied to pavements that are in good condition with the objective of keeping them in good condition and avoiding more costly repairs. This year's project is on local streets in the southeast area of Reno. Slurry seal is a preventative maintenance method for asphalt pavements. It is a mixture of liquid asphalt and coarse sand that is spread over asphalt using specialized equipment. Slurry seal protects the asphalt surface from weathering and helps to extend the overall life of the pavement.

Surface preparation may include patching and crack sealing.

An additional component of this project is wide crack mitigation on local streets in the southwest areas of Reno. This work includes grinding the pavement around the crack and patching with hotmix asphalt concrete.
