

Project Description & Purpose

The project includes improvements: infield and outfield at the northern baseball/softball field, installation of a new prefabricated restroom and the required utility service connections, access road and parking lot improvements, and mass grading of soccer fields identified in the park master plan to facilitate installation of soccer fields in subsequent phases.

Consultant services include: topographical survey of the site, base-mapping of underground and above-ground utilities, geotechnical investigation of site soils and associated laboratory materials testing, design services, and construction support.

Latest News September 2020

The low bidder for this project is Spanish Springs Construction, Inc. (SSC)

Construction began on August 19, 2020 and is currently on schedule for completion in the beginning of November 2020.

Since the project commenced, the Contractor has finished the mass grading of the soccer and softball fields, installation of the sewer and water utilities for the new bathroom, and will be completing the installation of the tie-in of the water and backflow preventer across Stead Boulevard. The new pre-constructed concrete bathroom will be transported to the site mid-October.
