



# FACE COVERINGS

## State of Nevada Directive 024: effective 6/26/2020

Children ages 2 to 9  
are strongly encouraged  
to wear face coverings  
when in public spaces.

Children ages 10 and  
above are required  
to wear face coverings  
when in public spaces.

- **Children age 10+ cannot attend camp without a face covering.**
- The City of Reno will provide one disposable face covering per child for Friday, June 26, 2020.
- **Parents will need to provide face coverings for their children. Please put your child's name on their face covering.**
  - A supply of homemade masks was donated to the City of Reno. Please take one if you would like to use it for your child's face covering.
- **If a face covering is lost during the day, and cannot be found, parent will be called to pick up their child or provide another face covering.**
  - If the City has a disposable supply available, we will provide the child with a disposable face covering for the remainder of the day. *Supplies are not guaranteed.*
- An accommodation can be made for those who have a mental health condition, medical condition, or disability that prevents them from wearing a face covering. Please complete an Assessment and Accommodation Form if needed.
