SUBJECT: Mid-Year Update on Fiscal Year 2024 Capital Improvement Plan Projects

During the Fiscal Year (FY) 2023-2024 Budget Workshop, the Council requested a mid-year update on the status of the CIP projects. This memorandum provides a status update (July 1—December 31, 2023) of the projects budgeted in the FY 2024 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP). The projects are identified on pages 280–284 in the <u>City of Reno Annual Budget</u>. For reference, below is a summary of the approved FY 2023-2024 CIP budget:

Overall, projects are moving forward in a productive manner, with several projects having already been completed in calendar year 2023. By the end of calendar year 2024, approximately 80% of the FY 2023-2024 budgeted CIP projects are estimated to be completed. The remaining projects are planned for completion in the calendar years 2024–2027. Factors that affect the completion dates include overall project complexity, phased timing, permitting approvals, the public outreach process, and the lead time to receive materials.
