


Ridership Trends: End Locations



Redistribution Activities (Summary)	FMs receive "out of nest" and "out of compliance" alerts for vehicles parked outside of corrals. They prioritize these alerts and rebalance vehicles into nests several times daily.
Theft/Vandalism and Resolution (Summary)	Bird has addressed issues such as intentional vandalism, including scooters in the river. In all cases, we've moved quickly to remove these vehicles from service (particularly any submerged vehicles) and to repair/recycle the vehicles.
